

The German police rely on ballistic brassieres

According to the German police, basic brassieres may represent hazards. 3000 women officials were ordered to use the new brassiere. This garment will form part of the German police officers uniform. They are of white color, in cotton, stuffed but no contain metal, and will be used to save thousands of police officers lives in Germany.

Thousands of German police officers will receive ballistic brassieres as part of their uniform and with the aim to enhance their safety when they are on guard duty.

According to the police officer who had the idea, Carmen Kibat, basic brassieres represent hazards for the officials when they wore bulletproof vests.

"The impact of the bullet may the plastic and metal pieces of the brassiere get into the police officer body and cause serious injuries." affirmed Carmen Kibat consultant in equality of opportunities for the Bundespolizei, the federal police force based in Hamburg.

The utilization of the ballistic brassieres pretends to increase the safety of the women officers when they are on guard duty.

The new gament looks like as a sport brassiere. It is white, made with cotton or polyester and have the word "Police" printed in the inferior part.

3000 women officials were ordered to use the new brassiere as part of their uniform, even if according to a spokeswoman of the German police, the utilisation will be "opcional".

Among the police officers, officials who work in airports, train stations, frontier posts are benefiting it.
